WELCOME NEW GOVERNING BODY MEMBERS

SECTION 41 FINAL DEMAND LETTERS

It is time to do your Section 41 Final Demand letters.

Send these out as soon as possible to your non-payers. They do get payments in. You can send out your Section 41 Final Demand letters as soon as you have processed your Exemption applications in the first term. This is common practice at schools that collect well.



CeeBee provides a service where we prepare and send out your Section 41 Final Demand letters via Registered email or Registered mail.

The only cost to the school is the actual per Registered email/mail costs:

- Registered emails cost R26.39 including VAT per email.
- Registered post via the post office cost R44.90 including VAT per letter.

The school is then given a copy of each letter and Registered receipt showing it was sent.

OUR PROCESS:

If you have sent your Section 41 Final Demand letters at the end of the first term, you can hand over your non-payers by the end of August. We particularly recommend handing over your Grade R-1 / Grade 8 parents as soon as possible. Once the parent has been handed over, they will be traced, and communicated with extensively by our trained collectors.

Parents are given a 21 day period in which to make a payment or payment arrangement. Failure to receive payment will result in the parents being credit listed. Should this process not elicit payment, the parent will be Summonsed, and Judgement will be taken at Court by CeeBee's Legal department.

CeeBee carries all the costs for the above actions.

WHAT IS NEW ON THE BELA BILL?

Latest amendment to the Basic Education Laws Amendment (BELA) Bill.

The National Council of Provinces (NCOP) has approved and passed the amended Basic Education Laws Amendment Bill, with eight of the nine provinces voting in favour of the changes. The passed bill, the amended D-bill, was adopted by all provinces except the Western Cape.

Some of the major changes coming to schools in the D-Bill include:

- Allowing schools to determine and develop their own language and admission policies, but giving the Department of Basic Education the final say;
- Regulating various aspects of school governing bodies;
- Making Grade R the new compulsory school-starting age;
- Criminalising parents who do not ensure their children are in school;
- Regulating home education;
- Confirming the ban on corporal punishment.
